Kolkata Educational Charitable Trust has been established with a vision of empowering underprivileged sections of the society through quality education. The Trust has started "KECT Academy "a Primary School programme in January 2019. The programme aims at reaching out to the slum dwelling population of Kolkata for the present.

Vision

To have a world in which every child is educated irrespective of class, creed or race.

Mission

To provide children from marginalised sections of the society with equal opportunity to education, development and participation, free of cost





KECT: IMPORTANT MILESTONES

- ♦ September, 2017: Meeting of like-minded people at Humayun Kabir Institute under the banner of "UZE" (Use of Zakat for Education) to establish a good English Medium School in Kolkata.
- September-October, 2017: A WhatsApp group with the same name formed by Jb S M Kalimuddin. Further discussions in smaller groups.
- November, 2017: "The Kolkata Educational and Charitable Trust" is formed with 9 founding trustees.
- After lot of discussions, researches and visits of educational institutions, it was decided to open a school for weaker section of the society.
- December, 2017: A space of around 1200 sq. ft. area was purchased at Panchanangram, Ghulshan Colony.
- December, 2018: Another 500 sq. ft. area purchased adjacent to the present one.
- 6th January, 2019: Formal opening of the School.
- ◆ 20th January, 2019: Montessori classes for 4+ and 5+ years started.
- 17th April, 2019: Class I started





The primary school program started in January 2019 with 70 children in the age group of 4 to 5 years. This is a Montessori programme that seeks children in their formative years, thereby enabling us to look at qualitative development of the child.

KECT Academy looks at all developmental needs for the child, including health, hygiene and nutrition, uniforms etc to name a few. Every child's academic and non academic growth is the responsibility of the school.

KECT introduced class 1 from April 2019.







Facilities at KECT Academy

- Free English medium education
- 2. Montessori method for around 100 Students in the age group of 4 to 6 years to strengthen foundation years
- 3. Primary school Class 1 CBSE curriculum
- 4. 1:20 teacher-students ratio along with care givers.
- Regular orientation of teachers and staff.
- 6. Admission after proper screening and door-to-door survey
- Ambience comparable to any quality school
- 8. Nutritious daily snacks for kids
- Periodical Health Screening for all kids
- Further Health Care for the kids who require medical intervention.
- Parental engagement through interaction and awareness programmes
- 12. Free Books, uniforms and all educational materials







Future Plan

- Adding atleast one class every year to make it a full-fledged school in next 5 years.
- Establishing a good quality English Medium School for all sections.
- Starting Skill Development Training for parents of students to help augment their income.
- Starting remedial coaching for students of higher classes.
